More power. The new Golf GTI EDITION 50¹ marks yet another milestone in the 50-year history of the iconic compact sports car: with an output of 239 kW (325 PS), the anniversary model is the most powerful of all series production Golf GTI models to date. A maximum speed of 270 km/h also makes it the fastest production model from the Volkswagen brand. Only the Golf R² also achieves this speed with an optional R-Performance package. Pre-sales for the Golf GTI EDITION 50 have already started.

More performance. The DCC sports chassis, front differential lock and the agile and precise progressive steering – all of which come as standard in the EDITION 50 – deliver driving dynamics in their purest form. Like the Golf GTI Clubsport³, the Golf GTI EDITION 50 also offers an additional driving profile: Special mode. The drive, steering and DCC sports chassis are consistently tuned to the special features of the Nürburgring Nordschleife.

More dynamic. The optional GTI Performance Package EDITION 50 reduces the GTI's weight by around 25 kg and delivers an additional boost to driving dynamics with its chassis upgrade. The package includes an exhaust system with titanium tailpipes, lighter 19-inch forged wheels (Warmenau design) and a modified chassis with further lowering (5 mm lower, now 20 mm). Paired with the package in this case at no extra cost: 235/35 semi-slick tyres⁴.

More refined. The exclusive standard equipment package⁴ includes features such as custom 19-inch alloy wheels (Queenstown design), GTI 50 logos on the roof spoiler and exterior mirror housings, privacy glazing in the rear, bumpers with a Clubsport look, black tailpipes, IQ.LIGHT LED matrix headlights and 3D LED tail light clusters. The interior is customised to match: sports seats with Clark GTI 50 seat cover pattern, GTI 50 logos (steering wheel, sill panel moulding, vehicle key), steering wheel trim and interior door handles in Dark Anodised finish (dark aluminium), red seat belts and red rubber pads on the accelerator and brake pedals.
