5) This engine/gearbox combination is equipped with a petrol particulate filter.

6) After one to three years, decorative films may show signs of use and ageing, especially when exposed to direct sunlight. In very hot climates, this can even occur during the first year.

If the decorative film remains on the vehicle for a longer period, visible differences may become apparent between the area of the paint finish protected by the decorative film and the uncovered areas.

All engines listed comply with the Euro 6 emissions standard.

All diesel engines listed are fitted with a multi-stage exhaust gas treatment system (diesel particulate filter and SCR catalytic converter).

Since 1 September 2017, certain new vehicles have been type-approved according to the Worldwide Harmonised Light Vehicle Test Procedure (WLTP), a new, more realistic testing process for measuring fuel consumption and CO₂ emissions. The WLTP will gradually replace the New European Driving Cycle (NEDC) from 1 September 2018. If NEDC values are specified as a range, they are not based on a single, individual vehicle and do not form part of the offer. They are provided purely for comparison purposes between the various types of vehicle. Additional equipment and accessories (attachments, tyre format, etc.) could change relevant vehicle parameters, such as weight, rolling resistance and aerodynamics. As well as weather and traffic conditions and personal driving style, these add-ons could also affect a vehicle's fuel consumption, power consumption, CO₂ emissions and performance.
